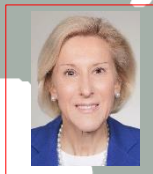

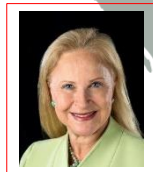
Global Economy Presentation by Dr. Sung Won Sohn

Dr. Sohn is Martin V. Smith Professor of Economics at California State University Channel Islands and Director of Institute for Global Economic Research (IGER). He is on the boards of Western Alliance Bancorporation and NACD Southern California. He is a Commissioner for LACERS which manages the \$13 billion of LA City Retirement funds. He was a Commissioner at the Port of Los Angeles, CEO of Hanmi Bank, Chief Economist at Wells Fargo Banks and an economist in the White House in Washington D.C. Dr. Sohn has served on numerous boards including First California Bancorporation and Forever 21.



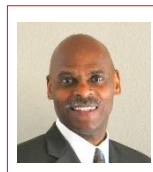
Corporate Governance Panel moderated by Dr. Karen Bogart
